"Is your child aged between 5-17? Have an EHCP or a diagnosis? Then they could be entitled to a free concessionary travel pass! Pop along and meet Rachael and Jaki, South Tyneside Council's Independent Travel Trainers who will support you to apply if they are eligible.

You will need to bring with you a copy of either a council tax/utility bill or a DWP letter (dated within the last 6 months) as proof of address, proof of diagnosis or EHCP, a headshot photo of your child and a letter from their school stating they attend 15 hours or more.

You can also find out about our independent travel training programme that equips and prepares young people with the skills needed for their next steps in life.

The ability to travel independently is a fantastic achievement for young people and has multiple benefits in their lives.
