RE Day April 2025

In Reception the children have been learning about the Easter story and how it is celebrated in churches over the Easter period. We talked about what we associate with Easter and then tasted hot cross buns and decorated eggs for our egg rolling competition later in the week.



In year I the children learned about the story of Easter, the importance of new life referring to Jesus and the associated symbols of Easter.





In year 2 they learned how Christians celebrate Easter and the different practices that take within Holy Week. They also looked at the symbols of Easter and why they are part of the celebrations.



In year 3 the children learned about Palm Sunday, why it is so important and looked at the symbols that represent it. They also recalled the Easter Holy Week celebrations.



In year 4 the children looked what Christians believe about Jesus. They also created their own ideas of how Jesus may have looked.



In year 5 the children learned why the Last Supper was so important to Christians. They also recalled the events of Holy week and Easter celebrations associated with it.



In 5 Red, we held a debate about the actions of Judas Iscariot during Easter week.
