



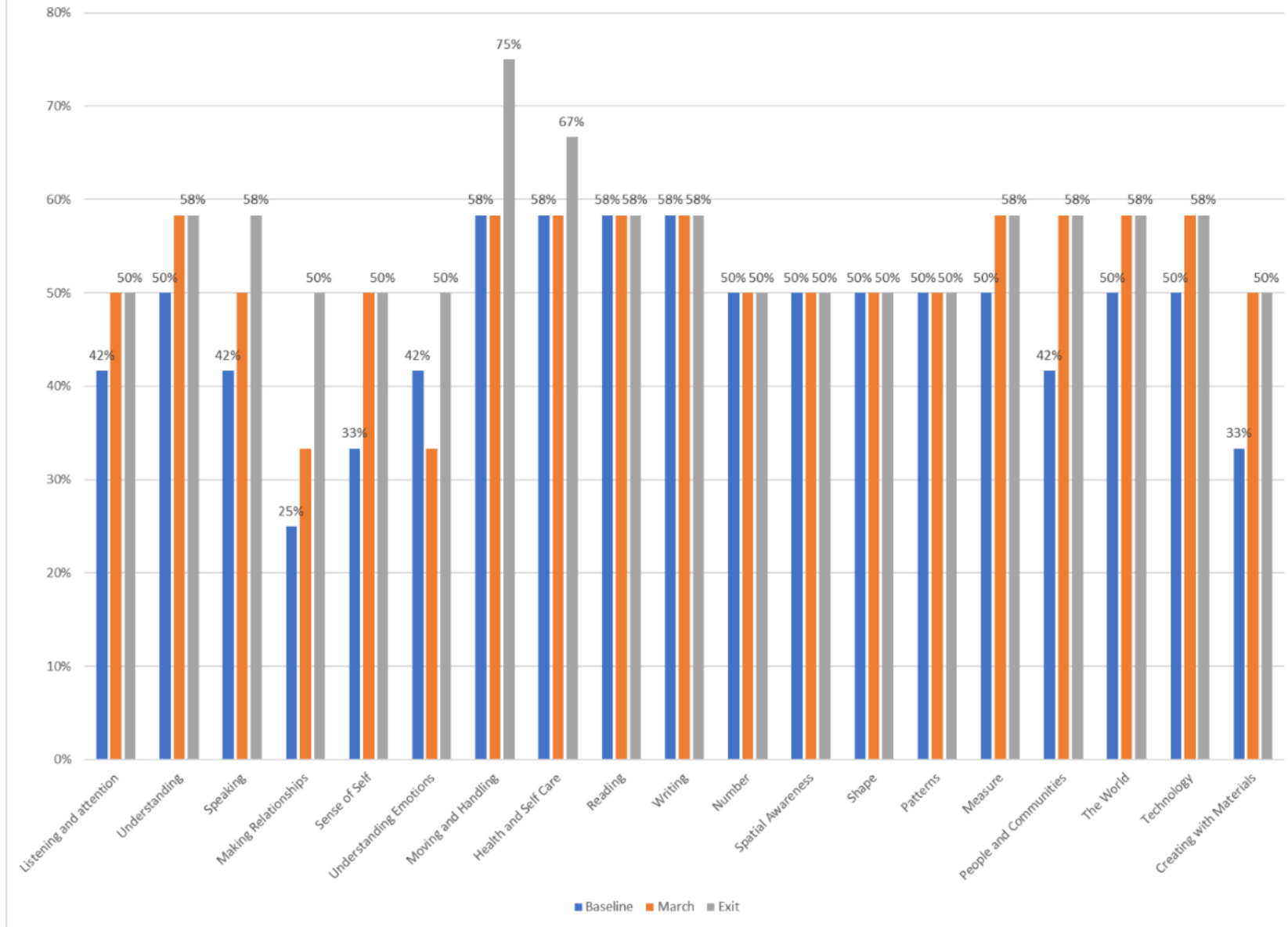

Overall – 56% achieving age related or above

- High numbers of SEND children within the EYPP group this year has impacted on the overall exit percentage.
- The gap closed the most within the Personal and Social areas of development, nursery was for some of the children was the first opportunity for them to build social skills with other children.
- Blast sessions had an impact on their communication skills, particularly understanding and speaking.
- Health and self-care showed an increase due to children's independence skills increasing.
