Uniform Thank you for your support with ensuring children are wearing the correct PE kit. However, we continue to have problems with children either not having appropriate PE kits, including the wrong shoes. PE is a statutory lesson, so legally we must

- A) make sure the child is participating
- B) ensure the child is wearing the correct clothes to participate safely.

Please note: If your child does not come in in the correct uniform, then they will be given a spare article of clothing. If you not wish this to happen, then ensure kits are in school. If you have any issues with purchasing the correct kit, then please speak to the class teacher or pastoral team: Miss Chilvers or Mrs Phillips.

Plain black or navy shorts

Plain black or navy jogging bottoms (winter)

Children will require indoor **plimsolls** and outdoor **trainers**

There are to be no logos on any part of the PE kit apart from the outdoor trainers.

Kits are to remain in school Monday to Friday.

School shoes— please remember that children must wear black shoes or black trainers only (no logos).

Attendance

Please remember, we are unable to authorise holidays or travel to a different country in term time. The first time it occurs -you will be fined, the second time—the fine will double and the third occasion may be a prosecution, incarceration and fine. Please remember the fine is per parent. This includes NOT taking your child out of school until the last day of term.

Road Safety

Please make sure that you accompany your child into school and do not allow them to cross the busy road (Brighton Road) on their own. Many families are pulling over and letting their children out onto the road; this has resulted in many near-misses. Remember, children from Reception to Year 4 must be bought INTO school unless you have a prior arrangement with the headteacher.
