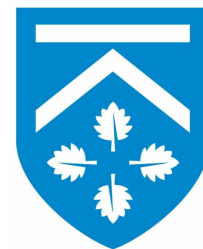
Visits to Primary Schools

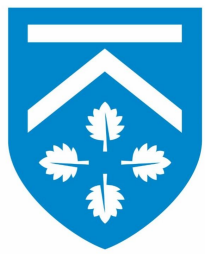

Supporting your Child



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- Kepier offers an extensive support network for all learners, this support includes:
 - Dedicated Coach (Form Tutor)
 - Designated non teaching Year Manager
 - Designated Year 6/7 SEND Support staff
 - Designated SEND Lead Learner Support
 - Senior Leaders with responsibility for Safeguarding, Wellbeing, Transition, Behaviour and Attendance
 - Access to School Nursing Teams
 - Dedicated School Counsellor
 - Access to a range of external agencies including Brook Listening Services, St Oswald's Bereavement Counselling, Resilience Nurses
- Over 40 different extra curricular activities take place each week from 2.50-3.50pm

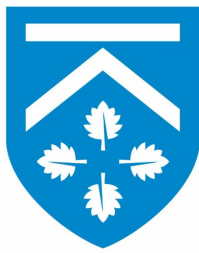


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- Year 7 learners start Kepier on Tuesday 5th September 2023 at 8.30am.

Uniform



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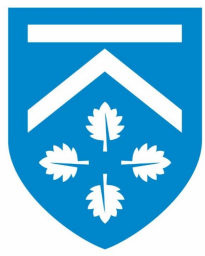
Our uniform consists of:

Ebacc Pathway



The EBacc is a set of subjects at *GCSE* that keeps young people's options open for further study and future careers.

The EBacc is:

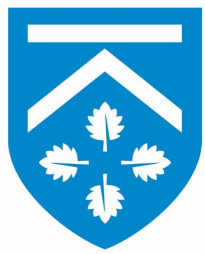
- English language and literature
- maths
- the sciences
- geography or history
- a language

Your child will follow the Ebacc pathway in Y9. Only a few learners will follow a different pathway.

The School will determine which learners they are.

The government's ambition is to see 75% of pupils studying the EBacc subject combination at *GCSE* by 2022, and 90% by 2025.

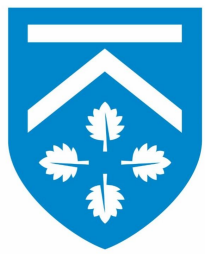
