

Laurus Ryecroft Sixth Form Appeals Process 2027-2028

If you had received a conditional offer of a place at Laurus Ryecroft Sixth Form but have now been refused admission, you are eligible to appeal against the decision to refuse you a place to an Independent Appeal Panel.

The Panel is made up of three independent volunteers who are trained to hear appeals and have no connection with Laurus Ryecroft Sixth Form. The Independent Panel has the authority to admit further students to the sixth form if they find any of the following:

- The oversubscription criteria have not been applied correctly in the circumstances of your case and this has resulted in you not being admitted;
- The admission of a further student to Laurus Ryecroft Sixth Form would not cause prejudice to the provision of efficient education and the efficient use of resources; or
- Your personal circumstances and reasons for appealing outweigh any prejudice to the school.

Please note: Students do not have grounds for appeal if they have not met our published entry criteria, unless they are an internal applicant who is being considered due to highly exceptional medical or social reasons.
