

Y5 Autumn Term Curriculum Overview

N.B. Core Subjects (English, Maths & Science) alongside RE, PSHE and PE will be a focus for the Autumn 1 half term.

English

A range of texts used to teach reading, writing & spoken English though shared or guided reading & class readers, including:

Narrative

'Cloud Tea Monkeys' by Mal Peet & Elspeth Graham. Plan and tell own versions of a familiar story

Non-narrative

'Crazy Creations Wallace and Gromit' - Explanations

Poetry

Structured Poetry:

'If Not for The Cat' by Jack Prelutsky

'Won Ton - A Cat Tale Told in Haiku' by Lee Wardlaw

'Won Ton and Chopstick - A Cat and Dog Tale Told in Haiku' by Lee Wardlaw

- Number Sense (place value, comparing, rounding and estimating with 5-digit numbers)
- Additive Reasoning (review of mental +/- e.g. forwards jump, partitioning & expanded partitioning, triple quad jump. +/- using formal written methods with more than 4-digit numbers, multistep problem solving inc. rounding & inverse to check and estimate, discrete data e.g. pictograms & bar charts)
- Multiplicative Reasoning (times tables & related ÷ facts, grid & partitioning to x & grouping grid/ chunking up to ÷ with up to 4digits by a one-digit number)
- Geometric Reasoning (identifying, draw, estimate & compare acute, obtuse and reflex angles. Investigate properties of rectangles & distinguish between regular and irregular polygons)
