Additive reasoning

Multiplicative reasoning

Recalling multiplication and division facts; mental methods to multiply; factor pairs, identifying patterns, dividing by 10 or 100; nverse, finding remainders & developing fluency

Identifying lines of symmetry, reflecting shapes along a line of symmetry; compare and classify quadrilaterals; compare and classify triangles; acute and obtuse angles; compare and order angles; regular and irregular polygons & quadrilaterals
