Count to & across 50, count in multiples of 2 and 10, recognise the different denominations of coins and notes, measure and record mass/weight; bonds to 10, 20 & 100, counting forward and back, counting in fives and tens; comparing numbers, representing numbers to 100, place value development of 2-digit numbers

• Additive reasoning

Read, write & interpret statements involving + & -, use number bonds and related subtraction facts to 20; mental + & -, developing written calculation strategies with 2-digits; using mathematical talk & varied fluency to solve problems, develop resilience

• Multiplicative reasoning

Solve one-step problems involving multiplication & division

• Geometric reasoning

Recognise & name 2D and 3d shapes, describe position, direction & movement; properties of 3d shapes, symmetry, 2d shapes on the surfaces of 3d shapes
