

Pre-Publication Consultation on Proposed Change to Age Range

Monkseaton Middle School; Vernon Drive, Whitley Bay, NE25 8JW

Local Authority: North Tyneside Council, The Quadrant, Silverlink North, NE27 9SU

Consultation Period: Wednesday 10th December 2025 – Wednesday 21st January 2026

What are we consulting on?

We are proposing to change the age range of Monkseaton Middle School from Year 5–Year 8 to Year 5–Year 11, effective from 1 September 2027. This means the school will offer education through to Key Stage 4, enabling pupils to complete their GCSEs at Monkseaton Middle School.

Why are we proposing this change?

- To meet local demand for additional secondary school places
- To provide continuity of education for pupils through to GCSE level from Year 5.
- To make best use of existing facilities and resources.
- To support long-term sustainability and improve parental choice.

Impact on pupil flows and local planning.

There is anticipated to be minimal impact of this change on schools in NEPA area. The impact at Y9 for High School is anticipated to be minimal due to significant oversubscription to WBHS. This indicates demand for additional places at Y9 in the NEPA area and wider borough. There is a potential impact on Secondary Schools at Y9, and Primary Schools at Y4, where pupils transfer into the NEPA schools (as is currently the case). It is anticipated that the pupils who start in Year 5 at MMS will remain until Y11, thereby the impact on Secondary Schools in the longer term is minimal.

Projected Costs and Long-Term Value for Money

The proposal is financially viable. School is projecting an in-year surplus by Year 3 of phased growth plan. The proposal provides Upper Key Stage 2, KS3 and KS4 education in one school.

Implementation Plan

The Implementation Plan is over three years. This will enable appropriate staffing appointments, training and resources to be in place. The school will increase to include Year 9 pupils in September 2027, Year 10 will begin September 2028 and Year 11 September 2029.

Curriculum Model at Key Stage 4

The KS4 curriculum will offer two pathways. These will include core subjects and option subjects. GCSEs include Maths, English Literature & English Language, Science, History, Geography, French, Spanish, German. Additional level 2 qualifications will be offered including Health & Social Care, Sport, Art &

Design, Computing, Technologies, RE/Philosophy, Hospitality & Catering, Animal Care. Work Based Learning opportunities will additionally be offered which include Vocational Awards in Hair & Beauty, Construction and Engineering.
