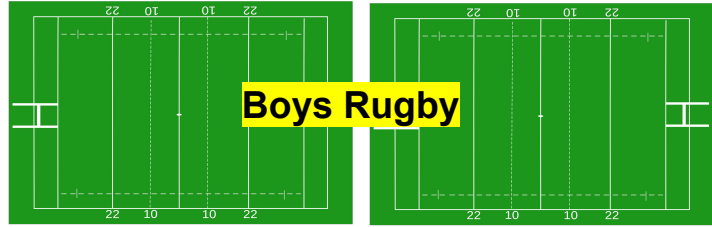
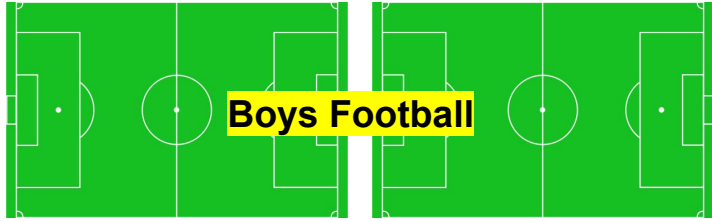

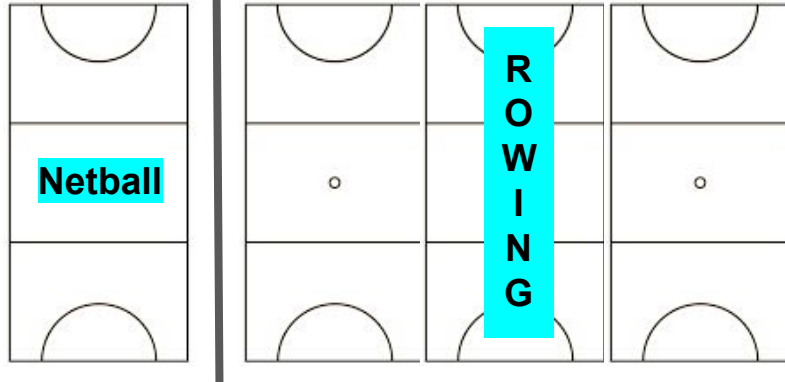

Bottom Field



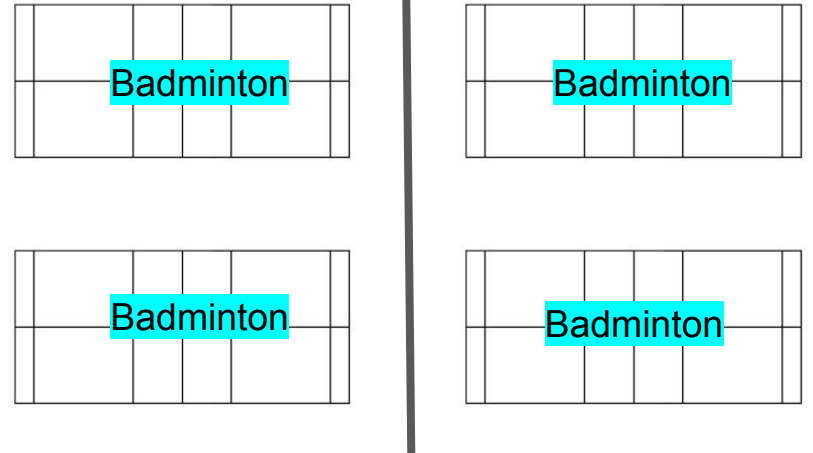
Netball Courts

What to expect at each location - Rules

Located on the bottom field, being staffed by Mr Bisson

Touch rugby rules of 6 touch turn-over.

Ball can be kicked at any time to reset the touches.

Watch for off-sides when there has been a touch pupils must get 3 steps backwards from the touch place.

5 points for a try and no conversions.

Badminton

What to expect at each location - Rules

- Games will be scored over a set time
- You are aiming to score as many points as you can in *each game*
- You win a point if:
 - a) Your opponents don't get the shuttlecock back over the net
 - b) Your opponents hit the shuttlecock out of the court lines.
- If you win the point, you serve again
- **Aggregate points win, so even if you are losing, keep scoring, you could still win overall even if you lose a game.**

Netball

What to expect at each location - Rules

- Don't worry too much about footwork - only blow the whistle on big, obvious errors.
- Do not allow contact or barging
- Watch obstruction - defenders must stand 3 feet away from the landing foot of the player with the ball
- Players can only hold the ball for 3 seconds
- The ball has to be touched in each third and received in the centre third on the centre pass.
