# Re: URGENT UPDATE - keyworker/vulnerable family school is open; school is closed to all other students until further notice. On-line lessons will be provided following students' normal timetables.

You will be aware that Prime Minister, Boris Johnson, has announced another national lockdown as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic. This means that school has to close again until further notice. This letter seeks to set out our plans and support for the coming weeks and months.

## **On-line Learning**

I have asked all staff to provide all year groups with on-line live lessons in coming days. Staff will deliver the students' normal timetable online. In a very few cases, the member of staff may just set resources, where they are unable to deliver a live lesson.

## Device Access – including mobile internet access

Thank you to those who have made contact to ask for a laptop. Many have already been distributed in the last few days – if you have requested one and have not yet received it, a member of staff will be in contact in coming days.

If you do not have a device such as a laptop or a tablet in your household, suitable for accessing Microsoft Teams, or you do not have access to the internet and require a dongle to access wi-fi, please email the senior team on slt@murraypark.derby.sch.uk and we will endeavour to provide one.

#### Year 11 Exams Cancelled

All Year 11 summer exams have been cancelled by the government. We have also taken the decision, in the interests of health and safety, to cancel the Engineering and Construction exams - for Murray Park students - due to take place next week. We will review the situation in relation to Health and Social Care, Hair and Beauty, Digital IT and Creative Media exams, due to take place from the end of January to March, once we have more information from the exam boards. We know this will lead to mixed emotions. Please be assured that all the work already completed to demonstrate a student's ability in their subject will not go to waste.

Planned mock dates have been postponed. Mock exams will now take place in normal classrooms, on our return, with the date to be confirmed. The results of these tests, along with evidence from previous assessments, classwork and homework, will be used to create the final grade which will be submitted to the exam boards. We are awaiting clarification, from the government, about how these grades will be calculated.

#### Year 9 Parents' Evening and Options

The Year 9 options process will move on-line this year. The parents' evening will take place on Tuesday 12<sup>th</sup> February, via phone call with class teachers. To prepare for this, there will be an Options Q&A Evening Tuesday 2nd February. Mr Hagen will be in touch closer to time with more information.

## **COVID** Testing

The testing kits have arrived in school; we have hired an agency to conduct the testing and assigned an area in school for the testing to take place. Initially we will only test staff and students currently in school – and only then those who have given permission. Further information will be sent once we have it.
