COVID-19 Arrangements

Given the fluid situation, nothing will change in terms of our COVID-19 measures this term; I will update you with the new COVID-19 arrangements for school, on our return.

New School Day Timings from September: 8.30am - 3pm

Thank you for completing the survey which was sent out earlier this week. We are pleased that the majority or staff and parents/carers believe that a move to an 8.30am start for everyone is an excellent way of increasing the time students have to read each day. We will therefore move to an 8.30am start from September. Should COVID-19 guidance move back to staggered starts, we will indeed adjust this as instructed by government guidance. We will also keep the designated food areas/zones for each year group, as most respondents felt this was preferable to mixed year groups.

School Uniform

I have attached a reminder about the school uniform requirements for September 2021. Please note the black or navy blue coat; length and material of the school skirt and the no-nose piercing rule. The uniform remains the same and Pupil Premium students will again receive subsidised uniform, trips and resources.
