- 4) Some exams are designed to be sat back-to-back such as English Literature 1 or French Listening & Reading
- 5) A small number of exam clashes have been identified. Students involved will be informed in advance and advised of what to do on the day.
- 6) All Year 11 students should remain available to sit exams until 29 June which is 'Contingency Day'. In the event of a national or regional emergency exams can be moved to this day.
