The Phlegrean Fields are a mythical destination. Located in the north-west zone of Naples, just 40 km far from Caserta, these places were named the "burning fields" by the Greeks: it's a supervolcano, now quiet, which has changed appearance many times over the millennia.

Visit volcanic lakes, geysers and witness volcanic mud bubbling out of the ground. The area was one of the first inhabited in Europe and has many historical buildings to explore.

### Day 2 - POMPEII

A visit to Pompeii allows students to see, hear and learn about the famous eruption in 79AD which buried and consequently preserved, this famous town. Exploring the site enables students to consider the town planning of the site and see some of the Roman architecture and frescos still visible.

You can wander the original streets with their shops and houses, visit the amphitheatre and the forum area and examine the preserved human casts, all in the shadow of the great Vesuvius.



A visit to this famous volcano is not to be missed! The mountain itself was once 3000m high rather than the 1281m of today.

Its violent outburst in AD 79 not only drowned Pompeii in pumice and pushed the coastline back several kilometres but also destroyed much of the mountain top, creating a huge caldera and two new peaks.

You will enjoy a guided walk around the crater and learn about the violent past of the volcano.






## Day 3 - AMALFI COAST & RAVELLO

The Amalfi Coast is a UNESCO World Heritage site, and once you have driven along the idyllic winds of the cliffs, through picture postcard scenery its easy to see why. You'll have photo stops en route as well as a couple of hours to explore Amalfi.

Your group will also explore the stunningly beautiful Ravello, set like an eagle's nest above the dizzying landscape of Italy's Amalfi coast.

Evening activities to be confirmed at parental forum.

Spending money, lunches and meals at airport.
