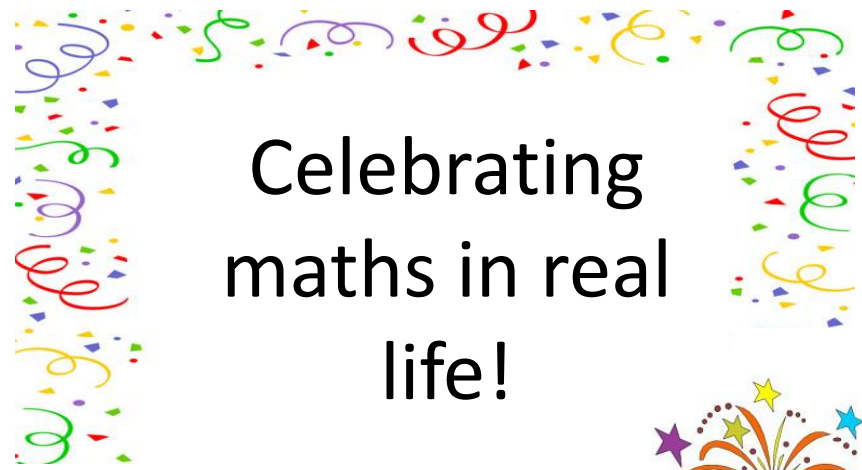

Your challenge is to complete a scavenger hunt activity around your house and garden.

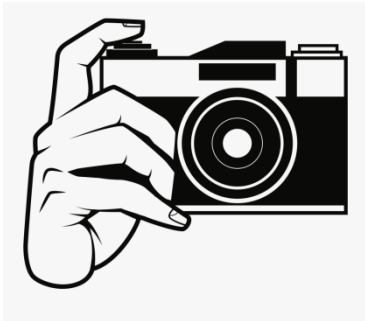
For each category, take a picture and upload it to your GoogleClassroom. If you don't have access to a camera, you can get a picture from Google Images.
