Newcastle based pub group brews up growth plans with £4.5m HSBC UK funding

One of the North East's largest leisure operators is expanding thanks to a £4.5m funding package from HSBC UK.

Newcastle based Vaulkhard Group, which owns a number of bars and pubs in the city, including Barluga, Redhouse and The Beehive, has purchased two pubs using the funding. The family-run business has acquired Town Wall and Bridge Tavern, both located in central Newcastle.

All 59 members of staff across both Town Wall and Bridge Tavern will be retained, seeing Vaulkhard Group reach a total of 350 employees. Vaulkhard Group is now looking to make further acquisitions in the North East over the coming years as it continues to grow its portfolio.

Sunderland film studios complex moves forward with plans to create 8,450 jobs

A "once in a generation" development, that could bring more than 8,000 jobs to the North East, has taken a step forward as public consultation gets underway, paving the way for a planning application later this summer.

FulwellCain Studios, a joint venture between Cain International and entertainment company Fulwell73, with strategic partner Sunderland City Council, announced plans earlier this year to deliver Crown Works Studios, one of the largest filmmaking complexes in Europe, creating some 8,450 jobs across the North East over the next decade.

Northumbria continues to climb up the rankings

Northumbria University is continuing to climb the national league tables, with an impressive seven place rise to rank 36th in the UK in the latest Complete University Guide.

The league table is the first of the key national university league tables to be published since Northumbria was named the UK University of the Year by Times Higher Education.
