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## Why is a Revision Timetable Important?

- A revision timetable is important because it:
- Helps you to organise your time
- Allows you to prioritise subjects and topics
- Ensures that you don't miss anything out
- Makes your revision more effective
- Reduces stress

# How Does A Revision Timetable Work?

**Do a timetable per week. Set specific but achievable goals**

**Split the time you have into manageable chunks**

**Have a different timescale for weekends when you have more time available**

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### Tips for Creating an Effective Revision Timetable

- Make it the first thing that you do as part of the revision process
- Know what time you have left and what you need to cover
- Plan well ahead
- Create one timetable for each week you have
- Make sure you have included all subjects and topics

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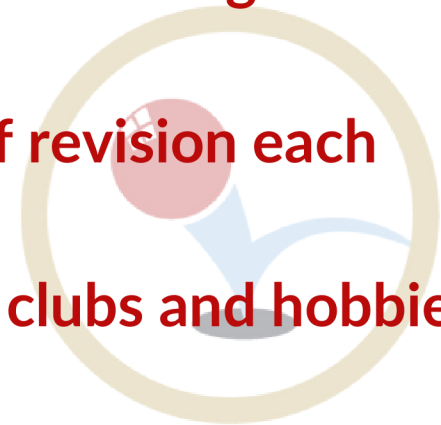


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## Tips for Creating an Effective Revision Timetable

- Split the time you have into manageable chunks
- Plan to do at least a bit of revision each day
- Include breaks, fun stuff, clubs and hobbies

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### Advanced Tips for Making Your Revision Timetable Better

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- Don't just revise one subject at a time. Space out and mix up subjects over the course of each week
- Return to each subject and topic after a period of time
- Do give yourself breaks and time to do the things you enjoy to prevent burn out



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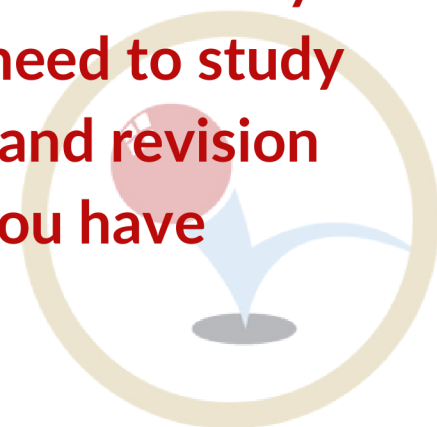


### Advanced Tips for Making Your Revision Timetable Better

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- Break your subjects down and identify the individual topics that you need to study
- Use subject specifications and revision guides to make sure that you have included all topics



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### Advanced Tips for Making Your Revision Timetable Better

- Effective revision is done in manageable chunks over a longer period of time. Don't overload your days / weeks



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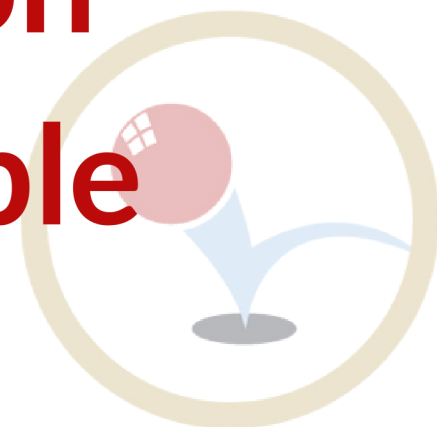
