## Knowledge organiser – Who am I? What does it mean to belong? (KS1)

### What will we be learning?

During this unit children will be taught knowledge, skills and understanding through learning about community and belonging.

### Key knowledge

#### Making sense of belief:

- Recognise that loving others is important to lots of communities
- Say simply what Jesus and one other religious leader taught about loving other people

#### Understanding the impact:

- Give an account of what happens at a traditional Christian or Jewish welcome ceremony and suggest what the actions and symbols mean.
- Identify at least two ways people show that they love each other and belong to each other when they get married (Christian / Jewish and non-religious)

#### Making connections:

- Give examples of ways in which people express their identity and belonging within faith communities and other communities, responding sensitively to difference.
- Talk about what is good about being in a community, for people of faith and for themselves, giving a good reason for ideas
- Talk about what I have learned and how I have changed.
