Knowledge organiser - Creation - What do Christians learn from the

Creation story? (LKS2)

What will we be learning?

Making sense of belief:

- □ Place the concepts of God and Creation of a timeline of the Bible's 'Big Story'.
- □ Make clear links between Genesis 1 and what Christians believe about God and Creation.

Understanding the impact:

Describe what Christians do because they believe God is Creator.

Making connections:

□ Ask questions and suggest answers about what might be important in the creation story for Christians living today and for people who are not Christians.

Key knowledge

Pupils will know that Christians believe:

- God the Creator cares for the creation, including human beings.
- As human beings are part of God's creation, they do best when they listen to God.
- The Bible shows that God wants to help people to be close to him he keeps his relationship with them and gives them guidance of good ways to live.
