### Covid Restrictions Reminders

Wear a mask or face covering / visor at all times in the yard and the paths surrounding the campus. If you are exempt from this please wear your exemption lanyard.

We do understand that sometimes children like to bring birthday cake into school when celebrating. Please note that cakes will be checked at the office before being given out. If a cake does contain peanut, it will unfortunately not be shared. This is to protect our children and staff.
