School Day

Please ensure you're on time for pick up and collection. A one-way system is in place. Please ensure you are maintaining social distancing at all times and a face covering is worn. Anyone arriving after their time must sign in as late at the main school office. The timings for drop off and collection are as follows:

Please do not block the green or red gates at the beginning or end of the day; this is to keep everyone safe.

Absences

If your child is absent from school for any reason please remember to inform us by **ringing the Main Office on 01670 812075 before registration ends at 9.30am**. Please be aware that it is our policy, if you do not let us know and we cannot get in touch with you, a home visit will be carried out.

Lunch Money

Lunch money is £11 per week or £2.20 per day and should be paid on a MONDAY morning for the week ahead. Please make sure any money sent into school is placed in a sealed envelope and clearly marked with the child's name, class, amount and what it is for.

Under the Universal Free Meals scheme children in Reception to Year 2 are entitled to a meal without charge.

Parents/ Carers on campus

Please can I remind you that if you need to speak to a member of staff that you do so by phoning the campus 01670 812075 and make an over the phone appointment or email admin@bishops.ncea.org.uk. This is to ensure everyone is kept safe. Thank you for your understanding.

School Uniform and P.E. Kit

Please make sure that all of your child's uniform is marked clearly with their name.

Just a reminder that learners should only wear black school shoes (no trainers, boots or sandals) while on the campus.

Children are not to have rucksacks or back packs. School book bags are available from our school uniform provider.

If your child has a Bishop's Primary hoodie and jogging bottoms, they are allowed to be in their PE kit for the day when it is their PE day. Please note: Only these items can be worn all day, no other sportswear.

If your child does not have or does not want the Bishop's Primary hoodie and jogging bottoms, they will need to bring in their PE shorts, top and sandshoes or trainers and leave them on campus.

We will try to ensure that you are notified in advance of any changes with PE days.
