Outdoors

- We spend a lot of our time in the outdoors which is a great place to learn and explore.
- Children need to bring a coat to school every day, even if the sun is shining.
- School shoes need to be appropriate for all weathers.
- We have some spare wellies in school but if a pair of your child's wellies could stay in school this would help. (Please put their name inside!)
- In hotter months please apply sun cream to your child before school and send them in with a sun hat.

Tapestry

- We use an online app called 'Tapestry' to share your child's Learning Journeys online.
- We just need an email to set up your Tapestry account. Please let us know if you are experiencing any difficulty accessing Tapestry at home.
- Observations can be seen of your child in school to see what they are learning.
- You can upload photos/videos to your child's Tapestry account which is really useful for us to see what they are interested in and what they have been doing at home.



Water bottles, Milk and Snack

Uniform

All children are expected to wear school uniform.
