

# Introducing our new school logo



We're delighted to share with you our brand new school logo!

As part of the process that began last summer to demerge the former Bishop's Primary School campuses into five separate schools in their own right, it was agreed that the four newly created schools, including William Leech C of E Primary School, would receive their own school logo.

We called upon our pupils to help us come up with a logo which would be truly representative of our school and the community in Lynemouth - something which would celebrate our heritage and school values and help people to understand what makes our little school so special.

We were really impressed with the quality of the designs we received, but we eventually narrowed the entries down to a shortlist of just three.

The final design, which is heavily based on the shortlisted entry submitted by Year 6 pupil, Billy, includes the colours of the Northumbrian flag, a lighthouse to reflect our LIGHT values, a row of houses to tip a nod to William Leech, the famed local builder from which our school gets its name and of course, a pickaxe to commemorate our village's mining past.

We really hope you like our new look, as you'll be seeing a lot of it! We will shortly be updating our signage around school, our website and social media channels, our letterhead and newsletters and in time, our school jumpers too.
