Today, children have been introduced to our new, simplified school rules:

- Be ready,
- Be respectful,

All of our adults will be using this language to support our children to make the correct choices for both their own learning and for the learning of their peers.

What do our new rules mean?

'Be Ready':

- Ready to learn,
- Ready to listen,
- Ready to participate,
- Ready to begin the day on time,
- Ready with the correct uniform, kit or equipment (eg: reading books).

'Be Respectful':

- Respect yourself and your learning,
- Show respect to your peers,
- Show respect to all adults,
- Show respect to our environment.

'Be Safe':

- Safe in your learning environment,
- Safe with the people around you,
- Safe in the activities in which you are taking part,
- Safe in your community.
