PΕ

Pupils in Alnwick class love to participate in guided dances and parachute games. We are going to develop our ability to follow instructions to move our bodies.

Self-Care

Pupils will continue to work on personal care at their own level, including washing their hands and face, brushing their teeth and hair and gaining independence using the toilet. Pupils continue to learn about their emotions.

My World Science – History – Geography

My Communication

Phonics

Some of our pupils will continue to work on their oral blending of words, other pupils will continue to recall letter sounds we have previously learned. We will be introducing new sounds; o, c, k, u and b.

Story

The Very Hungry Caterpillar Pupils will learn the story of the Very Hungry Caterpillar, with some sensory experiences.

Communication and Language

Alnwick Class will have SaLT input from Nichola Shaw this half term, she will be spending some full days in class to support pupils with their SaLT targets and get some new systems up and running! Some pupils will continue to use Colourful Semantics to develop their sentence structure and descriptive language. Other pupils will begin to use PECS and communication books. We are very excited to have Nichola helping us.

My Thinking

Number

Alnwick class will continue listening to our favourite number rhymes. Pupils are able to fill in blanks from a number rhyme, and they also enjoy joining in with some actions.

Big and Little

Pupils will begin to compare objects of different sizes, also sorting objects by their size "big" and "little".

Patterns

Pupils will be able to identify a pattern. We will begin to recreate patterns using 2D and 3D shapes.

My Creativity

Music

Music links to most subjects for Alnwick class, including Numeracy, PSHE and Literacy. Songs of reference are played throughout the day. In Music lessons, we will explore nursery rhymes and we will begin to discuss how different music makes us feel.
