FOOD SCIENCE ASSISTANT

Helping with food preparation, safety and nutrition projects.

PHARMACY ASSISTANT

Helping with prescriptions and stock management.

Working in zoos, kennels or veterinary practices.

CAREERS IN HISTORY

Helping with geography-related activities like nature walks or map-reading workshops.

CAREERS IN RE

RE TEACHING ASSISTANT

Supporting teachers in delivering RE lessons and helping pupils develop their understanding of faith and belief.

ETHICS OR FAITH ADVISOR

Providing guidance on ethical issues in areas such as business, healthcare or public services.

YOUTH WORKER

Working with young people in church or community settings, supporting their personal and spiritual development.

Creating resources and programmes that help others learn about religion, belief and values.
