At Warkworth Primary School we have a team of governors that work as volunteers to support the school. Their role is to support and challenge the Head teacher and to help set the vision and strategic direction of the school ensuring that our school is the very best it can be. Governors have a wide range of duties and tasks but their 3 core functions are:

- Ensuring clarity of vision, ethos and strategic direction
- Holding executive leaders to account for the educational performance of the organisation and tis pupils, and the performance management of staff; and
- Overseeing the financial performance of the organisation and making sure its money is well spent.

We have three Full Governing Body meetings each year held in the Autumn, Spring and Summer terms. A range of subcommittee meetings also take place at least once per term. During these meetings we look at a wide range of information to find out how well the school is performing. Mrs Ritson provides a detailed Headteacher's report at these meetings but governors also look at data and independent reports so that they can make their own decisions about how well things are going. To support the work that goes on, governors also try to visit school as often as possible.
