I am writing to you in my capacity as the safeguarding lead for NCEA Warkworth Primary, to outline how we will continue to support families and children through the most recent school closure due to the COVID 19 outbreak. Even though the school will be partially closed, we will endeavour to support and safeguard all children and to offer advice and support where needed.

Please be assured that I will also make personal contact as soon as I am able to hold conversations on how best to support individuals during this time.

Our school will remain partially open for children of key workers, vulnerable children and we will continue to ensure that food vouchers are provided for those who are entitled.

Staff will regularly check dojo messages, emails and respond to concerns, as well as alert me via our Safeguard system to any issues arising. You can continue to use the school phone number to report any concerns, and we will do what we can to support and help.
