## **PURPOSE OF JOB:**

The purpose of this role is under the direction of the Assistant Principal, Behaviour and Engagement, or other nominated person, to ensure the safety, welfare and good conduct of students during the breakfast club period.

## **EMPLOYMENT DUTIES:**

Individually or as part of a team, Include but are not restricted to:

- 1. To help prepare the Breakfast Club room by setting out a suitable range of activities and furniture to engage the students when they arrive.
- 2. To maintain a Breakfast Club register of names of children including details of the time each child arrived.
- 3. To assist with the serving of a variety of breakfast food and drinks cereals, juice, toast and other provisions.
- 4. To supervise the safety of students and ensure their wellbeing at all times.

- 5. To interact with the students by joining in play and activities and engaging them in general discussion.
- 6. To evaluate the children's daily programme and routine and ensure that all necessary matters are communicated to the Primary Leader.
- 7. To ensure the provision of a high quality environment appropriate to the needs of students from differing cultures and religious backgrounds and at all stages of development.
- 8. To comply with Health and Safety Regulations and maintain a high standard of cleanliness and hygiene.
- 9. To carry out any other duties which fall within the broad spirit, scope and purpose of this job description and which are commensurate with the grade of the post.

The person undertaking this role is expected to work within the policies, ethos and aims of the school and to carry out such other duties as may reasonably be assigned. The duties of this post may vary from time to time without changing the general character of the post or level of responsibility entailed. You may be required to carry out additional duties commensurate with the level of the role.
