Homework

The weekly Maths and spellings homework will continue. Children also need to be reading at least 4 times each week and bringing in their signed Reading Records, please. Using Hit the Button or Timestables Rockstars 4 times a week (just for 10 minutes each time) would really help with this and make all of the Maths work we do far more accessible.

English

English will be led by the fantastic books 'Friend or Foe' and Rose Blanche. We will be writing both character and setting descriptions, then a dialogue. We will finish the half term with war themed poetry. Reading will again be a mix of whole-class and group reading sessions. Grammar will be taught once a week separately and consolidated in our reading and writing. Spelling tests will be on Fridays.

Maths

We begin the term with place value and partitioning, working with numbers up to a million. We will be rounding numbers to 10,100,1000 and 10,000, counting forwards and backwards including negative numbers. We then move onto column addition, subtraction, multiplication and subtraction. All the way through we will be using our learning to practise our fluency and problem solving.

Science

We will study the parts and life-cycles of plants and flowers. We will then look at different ways plants produce, seed dispersal and how to grow plants without a seed.

Art & Design Technology

This half term the children will use pencils and charcoal to learn how to create a portrait. They will study the work of Kathe Kollwitz then build up gradually to create portraits of WWII soldiers.

Music

Music will be taught by Mrs Furmidge. We will be listening and responding in various ways to songs from WWII.

We will begin our coding work in Purple Mash, as well as using The Internet to research.
