My Child at School (MCAS)

My Child at School (MCAS) is now live! This is a gateway enabling parents to view their child's academic performance in real-time via a web browser. This facility allows exclusive access to a student's information such as attendance, timetable, homework and behaviour whenever the parent/carer wishes.

You should have received an invitation to create an account. If this has not appeared in your inbox or junk mail, please follow the steps below to create an account.

Search 'My Child At School' on the internet and go to the log in page. Click' reset password' and enter the email address you have previously given to the school, then click 'send reset email'. This will send you a link to create your password.

Once you have created your account you can then download the MCAS app and use your details to log in. Please ensure you enable push notifications when you install the app to receive message notifications.
