Settling in to Reception

Baseline assessments
The first few weeks will be spent getting to know the children and completing our baseline observations. The children have been in continuous provision playing and getting to know the classroom routines and their classmates.





We have 6 golden rules that we follow in our classroom. We have introduced these through stories and reinforce them through our class reward system.



A day in Reception

- •We teach the curriculum through short class carpet sessions throughout the day.
- •Focus group activities are led by an adult, this will include indoor and outdoor learning.
- •Independent activities are planned to reinforce learning.
- •In continuous provision children explore learning further.

We will be giving out a weekly GROW certificates and the GROW book on a Friday to a child who we have seen demonstrating these qualities.

























Your child will choose a library book everyThursday to bring home and share with their grown up each week. Please return these every Wednesday

Children will be given a reading book every Friday to share with their grown up at home. Please return these every Friday


Little Wandle Phonics & reading meeting
