English

Grammar will be taught once a week separately, and consolidated in our reading and writing.

In addition to this, children will be reading in groups and as a whole class. They will also be encouraged to use the library.

Maths

This half term we will be learning about multiplication and fractions. If your child is not yet confident with times tables, please encourage them to practise as they are the foundation for so much of our maths work.

Science

This half term we will be looking at materials and their properties in science. We will be sorting materials in a variety of ways and separating materials using evaporation, filtering and sieving.

Art

This half term we will look at the work of Henri Rousseau. We will use painting and drawing techniques to create our own work inspired by his paintings that include animal movement.

Music

In Music, the children will be composing their own rainforest-inspired soundscapes using images from our artist Henri Rousseau.

This half term we will be looking at Internet safety. This will include us learning about taking responsibility when online, protecting our privacy, suitable sources and focusing on the reliability of the type of communication we use.
