Year 5 Author Experience

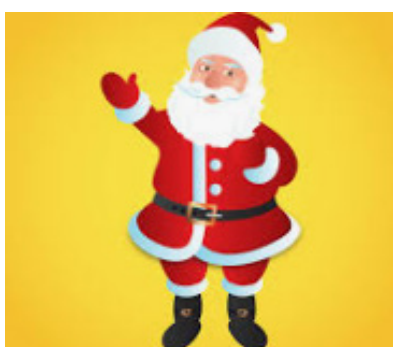
This week, year 5 have been delighted to welcome Tony Bradman, the author of *Anglo Saxon Boy* to read the final chapter of our class novel via Zoom.

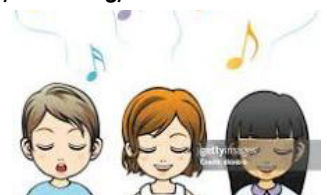
