Branching Out Kids Club - Reminder

Payments should be made directly or by Tax-Free Childcare or Workplace vouchers. Once the credit has been applied to your MCAS account (this can take up to a week), you can book sessions directly through the app. If all of your credit appears under one club (e.g. Breakfast Club) and you need to move some to Afterschool Club, email kidsclub@norrisbank.org.uk stating the amount you would like transferred. Please note that credits cannot be shared between siblings Tax-Free Childcare accounts. Through exciting activities and discussions, they'll learn how small actions can make a big difference for our planet.

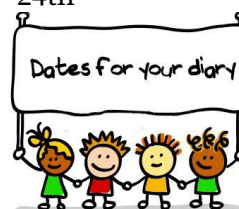
