



School Uniform Policy

School Uniform

We feel that a school uniform encourages children to identify with and take pride in their school. It also helps to ensure that children are suitably dressed to enable them to focus on their work.

Parents and carers are therefore requested to send their children to school in uniform consisting of:

School Uniform
Norris Bank Primary School crew neck jumper or cardigan with school logo or Plain Dark Green crew neck jumper or cardigan without school logo
White or green polo shirt with or without school logo
Grey skirt/pinafore/trousers/shorts Green gingham summer dress
Black school shoes – no trainers
Grey tights, socks - ankle or knee
Norris Bank Primary School Book Bag with school logo

Please ensure all items have the child's name written in them.

Clothing for Art and Technology

In addition to the main school uniform, for Art and Technology, the children need a shirt (preferably a large one) to protect their clothes.

Clothing for Physical Education and Games

All P.E. clothing and shoes should be kept in a bag with the child's name clearly marked on the outside.

Indoors

All children need a white t-shirt and black shorts with an elasticated waist for indoor lessons. In addition, a pair of black plimsolls are required. These can also be used when a change of shoes is necessary due to very wet weather.

Outdoors

For general games lessons taken outdoors, children from Year 1 onwards need a warm change of clothes, i.e. a black tracksuit top and bottoms, and a pair of strong trainers.

Forgotten Kit and Fitness

When games kit is forgotten, children will be asked to wear a coat and go outside to watch the activities. As a general rule, if children are fit enough to attend school, they should take part in all activities. On the rare occasions when a child is not fit for P.E. or games, or swimming, a note should be sent from home to this effect.

Jewellery and watches and hair accessories
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hair accessories, such as clips or slides, are to be PLAIN Dark Green only and hair bands to be no wider than 5cm. • NO jewellery of any kind may be worn by any pupil in school AT ANY TIME with the exception that studs may be worn for a period of six weeks after ear piercing. • In the event of studs being worn they must be removed or taped up during PE (with tape provided from home). • Watches, except for smart watches which are not allowed, may be worn but the school cannot take responsibility for the safety of watches.

We encourage parents and carers, wherever possible, to re-use school uniform by passing it on to younger siblings in the family; or donating items that are still in good condition.


Any unnamed items not claimed will be recycled as second hand uniform and offered to parents and carers free of charge at the end of each term.
