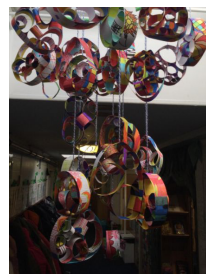
A huge well done to all the girls for their effort. Special mentions go to Martha for her brilliant defending and Luna, for her leadership skills.

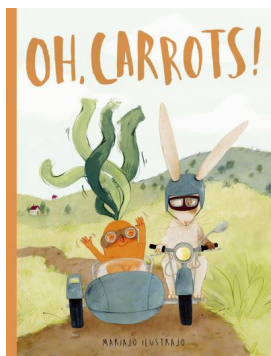
