We will be continuing to focus on accurately writing a sentence using the high five sentence structure. We will also be looking at continuing to improve our sentences by adding adjectives and using proper nouns.</p>	<p>Maths</p> <p>This half term in maths we will be looking at multiplication and division by counting in 2s, 5s and 10s as well as grouping and sharing strategies. We will also be finding halves and quarters of shapes and amounts. We shall continue our calculation strategies that we have previously learned in our daily arithmetic sessions.</p>
<p>History</p> <p>In history we will be learning to ask and answer questions using artefacts and photographs. We will be learning to give a plausible explanation about what an object was used for in the past. We will be exploring what transport was like in the past.</p>	<p>PSHE</p> <p>In PSHE we will be learning about what makes us healthy and why it is important to be healthy in terms of exercise, eating healthily and keeping safe in the sun.</p>	<p>Music</p> <p>In music we will continue with using percussion instruments to explore tempo, timbre and pitch.</p>
<p>ICT</p> <p>This half term in ICT we are going to practise the skills we have learnt this year by making our own animated story and saving it to our work folder and retrieving it to continue weekly.</p>	<p>D and T</p> <p>In design and technology we are going to be researching and analysing wheeled vehicles. We will use our findings to design and make our own vehicles with axles and wheels. At the end of the unit we will be racing our wheeled vehicles to see which one is the fastest.</p>	<p>RE</p> <p>In RE we will be looking at belonging to a faith community and discussing ways in which Christians celebrate this. We will be learning about Christians and marriages in the Christian community.</p>
