Maths

This term, year 4s are focusing on multiplication and division, area, fractions and decimals. Times tables and mental arithmetic will be practised daily to improve rapid recall skills. By the end of Year 4 we expect children to know all times table facts up to 12x12. Our year 4 children will sit a statutory multiplication test in June to check their knowledge.

The year 3s will focus on multiplication and division, money, statistics, length & perimeter and fractions. Times tables and mental arithmetic will be practised daily to improve rapid recall skills. By the end of Year 3 we expect children to know all times table facts for the 2, 3, 4, 5, 8 and 10 times tables.

Times tables tests will be completed frequently in school to practise quick recall. Please support your child in learning their times tables – you could quiz them on the way to and from school!

TTRockstars is a brilliant way of having fun whilst learning times tables. Look out for battles against other classes!



RE

Our first topic that we will look at this term is Journeys (Local Church). In this topic, we will look at the journey we take through the Liturgical Year. We will also take some time to explore the Eucharist and the importance of Holy Communion.

In our Lent/Easter, we will focus on Lent as a time of giving more to those in need.

English



This term, we will look at the genres of story-writing, diary entries, letters, poetry, persuasive posters and non-chronological reports. All our writing will link to our Geography topic, Extreme Weathers.

In our reading sessions we will practise comprehension skills to help our understanding of a text.

Grammar, punctuation, spelling and handwriting will be practised daily in class. Our spellings are taken from the Year 3 and 4 word lists and explore how sentences can be written using different structures.

Finally, we will be encouraging all children to speak clearly in full sentences, as this is a focus we are having throughout the year.

Science



During the Spring term, year 4s will be learning about Electricity and will be building their own circuits. They will then be exploring Living Things and their habitats.

Year 3s will be learning about forces and magnets firstly and then moving on to explore rocks and learning about how rocks and fossils are formed.

PSHE

This term in PSHE we will be exploring how we continue to explore our health and well-being, living in the wider world and how to maintain good friendships with others.



PE

This term in PE the children will be busting a move to Urban Kaos. We are already very excited about performing our dance routine!

We will then move on to tennis and learn a range of techniques and rules of the game.

P.E lessons will take place on a Monday afternoon and a Tuesday morning so please remember to have PE Kits in school at all times (white tops/red shorts and trainers).

French

Bonjour tout le monde! In French we will be learning about different celebrations and French cities. We will also continue to practise numbers to 30 and the days of the week.

Art will be based around the Japanese artist, Hokusai. The children will explore painting and collage skills.

In Music the children will be listening to the music and learning to play the recorder.

In D&T children will be learning how to use a range of materials to create an item of clothing.

This term, we will be exploring the use of data and programming.


Please encourage safe internet use at home and good and legal use of social networks.
