If you or a friend have been offered gifts off a stranger;

If you are worried about anything.

What to do if you feel unsafe Online.

- 1. Take a screen shot of the message or picture making you feel uncomfortable.
- 2. Block the person and or report it via the social media reporting button.
 - 3. Tell a responsible and trusted adult.
