Dear Parents and Carers

As we move into the final part of our Summer Term I will be taking the opportunity to revisit the uniform expectations. It would be fair to say that, in the last term, we have a number of interpretations of what is and is not acceptable uniform and we believe it is time to clarify our expectations for pupils and parents. We will be looking to make sure that uniform is correct and worn correctly in September; however, after half term we would like to address the expectations for jewellery and makeup.

As of Monday 6th June, the following expectations will be a focus;

- No jewellery, rings, or retainers in piercings
- Discrete use of tinted moisturiser and mascara is permitted but no other makeup, or nail varnish

Full parental support is absolutely vital so that our uniform and appearance is of a high standard. All pupils are expected to wear school uniform (including during periods of travel). We believe that wearing a uniform helps create a feeling of unity among the pupils and strengthens their sense of belonging to the school community. Here is a reminder of our school uniform that has been consistent since 2018:

- Traditional black school blazer with school badge on the left pocket
- Plain black school tailored trousers (worn with plain black socks) or, plain black school knee length pleated skirt (worn with opaque black tights)
- Plain white school shirt with top buttoning collar
- School Year Group or Prefect Tie
- Plain black sensible, polishable shoes (no trainers)
- Optional plain black v-neck jumper with school motif
