School Dress Code



Article of Uniform	Required uniform *All branded uniform can be purchased from our supplier Motif8	Optional uniform
Blazers	Branded black blazer with school badge.	
Jumpers		Non-branded or branded black jumper.
Trousers	Non-branded black trousers. Trousers must be tailored or flared fit. Leggings/Jersey material or gym/sport (including a sport/gym flare) style trousers are against policy.	
Skirts	Non-branded black pleated skirt. Must be knee length and worn with plain black tights.	
Shirts and Blouses	Non-branded white non-fitted school shirt with a top button fastening. Must be tucked in to skirt or trousers.	
School tie	Branded school tie. Must be worn covering the top button of the shirt.	
School Bag	Non-branded school bag. Should fit an A4 ring binder/A4 books. Must contain pencil case (including two pens, a pencil and ruler) and student planner.	

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PE kit	Students are required to change for PE even if they are not fully participating for medical reasons.	
PE shirt	Branded PE top from Motif8 .	
PE shorts	Branded PE shorts from Motif8 .	
Other PE bottoms		Non-branded black PE leggings / tracksuit bottoms (if wearing non branded shorts / leggings / tracksuit bottoms, these should be plain black and should not have expensive sports brand logos or designs). Flare gym leggings are against policy due to health and safety.
PE zip-up		Branded or non-branded zip-up PE black jacket.
PE trainers	Non-branded suitable black trainers. No plimsolls or other leisure shoes are appropriate for PE.	

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Article	Acceptable	Not acceptable
Jewellery		On health and safety grounds, we do not allow children to wear jewellery in our school, other than a religious pendant. Earrings are not acceptable even when covered.
Watches	In line with guidance from The Association for Physical Education (afPE) children are required to remove watches during PE lessons to prevent them from causing injury.	Watches with additional features including internet access, such as Apple and iWatches are not acceptable as they are treated under the mobile phones rule.
School shoes	Suitable, plain and unbranded black shoes (polishable) should be worn.	Trainers, plimsolls or any form of canvas shoe are not acceptable.
Makeup and beauty treatments	Discreet, natural makeup is allowed.	False eyelashes are against school policy. Nail varnish, gel nails and false nails are against school policy. All hairstyles should be in keeping with our smart school uniform - extreme hair colours are not acceptable.
