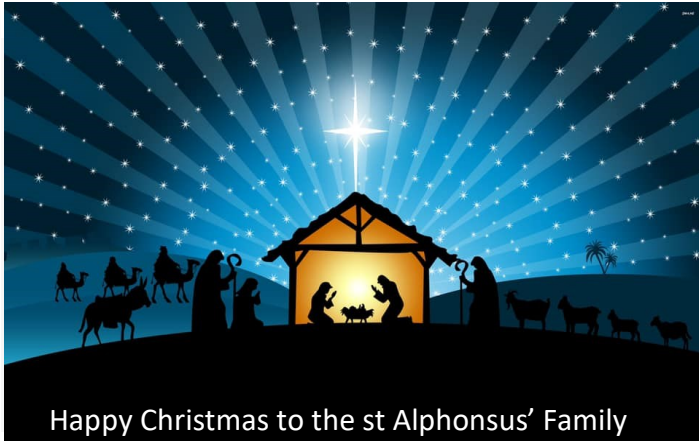

Year 2 = 95.7%

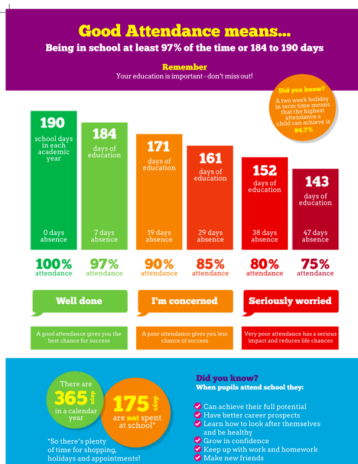
Year 3 = 96.1%

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Over the Christmas period, if your child receives a positive test for Coronavirus (COVID-19) **and developed the symptoms within 48 hours of last being in school** you must notify school using the following email address:

covidpositive@stalphonsus.npcat.org.uk

Please leave your telephone number and you will receive a call to ascertain details as Public Health England need to be informed.

If a positive case is confirmed in your child's class during this period, you will receive an email from school notifying you of this.

School Uniform—Reminder

Please ensure that your child is in full school uniform for school. Jogging bottoms and jeans are for weekends. Children must wear school trousers or skirts / pinafore for school. Jewellery, including earrings and painted nails are not permitted.

Wherever possible, PE will continue to take place outdoors. Please can you ensure that your child has both an indoor and outdoor kit in school. (PE kit: black / navy shorts and white / house coloured t-shirt with suitable footwear (plimsolls or trainers), outdoor: black / navy jogger).
