THE GOSPEL IN CHURCH Sunday 3rd October 2021



People were bringing little children to be with Jesus. Truly I tell you, anyone who does not welcome the kingdom of God like a little child will never enter it." Then he put his arms round the children and gave them his blessing.

Openness to Jesus helps us draw closer to God. Ask your child what the word 'openness' means to them. Who is usually open with them - ready to listen to and support them? How does it make them feel when people are open with them? Good relationships depend upon openness. What happens to a family or community when people are open with each other?

How can we be more open to God and to others in this coming week?
