
### Year 5 Worship and Reflection Tuesday 1st December 2020

#### Introduction

On Sunday 29<sup>th</sup> November we celebrated the first Sunday of Advent. This is a special time when we get ready for the coming of Jesus. Jesus asks us all to keep watch for him so that we will be ready when he comes.



#### Key Scripture

'Be on watch, be alert Mark 13:33-37



'Jesus said, "Be on watch, be alert, for you do not know when the time will come. It will be like a man who goes away from home on a journey and leaves his servants in charge, after giving to each one his own work to do and after telling the doorkeeper to keep watch. Be on guard, then, because you do not know when the master of the house is coming — it might be in the evening or at midnight or before dawn or at sunrise. If he comes suddenly, he must not find you asleep. What I say to you, then, I say to all: watch!"

#### Reflection

The first candle on the Advent Wreath represents Hope, so as part of our reflection, the children said what they thought hope is and what their hopes for the future are.
