

### **Literacy**

Children will develop a wide range of vocabulary through stories and songs. In phonics, we focus on different sounds around us before moving onto letter sounds that the children will start to recognise at the beginning of words. Some will be able to read simple words independently through decoding.

In writing, the aim is for the children to write some or all of their names as well as some other letters.

### **Understanding the World**

Children will develop a positive attitude when exploring how everyone is different. They will explore and learn to care for things in the natural world and learn about life cycles. They will become aware of how people in other countries live differently to us.

### **Religious Education**

In Nursery children will take part in a weekly RE lesson. Children learn the Sign of the Cross and take part in simple prayers throughout the day. Some topics in class will also link to religious themes, such as Creation, Christmas and Easter.

### **Maths**

Children will learn to recite numbers to 10 and count out different amounts. They will look at 2D shapes and simple 3D shapes as well as the mathematical language used to describe them. We will also focus on positional language and simple real life maths problems.

### **Personal, Social and Emotional**

Children will develop a skill to choose the correct resources needed to complete their chosen task. They will work with peers to solve any conflicts. They will begin to use their imagination to make up their own games with friends.

Also, they will become aware of the feelings of others around them.

### **Expressive Arts**

Children will learn about colour mixing, exploring different materials and have musical opportunities to explore instruments. They will use construction and other resources to support their imaginative play.

### **P.E. and Games**

During PE and Games the children will learn to move in different ways in a controlled manner. They will also work as a team to complete a task and listen and learn simple instructions to play games.

### **Communication and Language**
