

## Reception Parent's Information




## Friday 8th October 2021



The children have continued to enjoy sharing the Colour Monster story this week. We have spent some time discussing our feelings, when they may change and why. We have also talked about how we can help each other when maybe we are feeling a bit sad (blue), scared (black) or angry (red). The children enjoyed making their own colour monster by painting an old cardboard box in our outdoor area and taking photographs of each other representing different feelings with facial expressions.

In Maths this week, we have been sorting and comparing different objects. We read and enjoyed the story Button Box and then looked at our own box of buttons. We tried to find two buttons that matched, discussed what was different and sorted them into the same colours, size, shape and by how many holes. The children also helped their teachers sort all the muddled socks into pairs and were fantastic at playing a memory matching card game. What a busy week!





In phonics this week we have learnt the phonemes ck, e, u, r. The children have begun to blend some of the graphemes we have already learnt (s, a, t, p, i, n, m, d, g, o, c, k). We are so proud of the progress the children have made in phonics and they have all been very excited to take home their 1st school reading books home this week. Please may you ensure that they bring their books into school everyday. Thank you.
