Our school target is 97%.

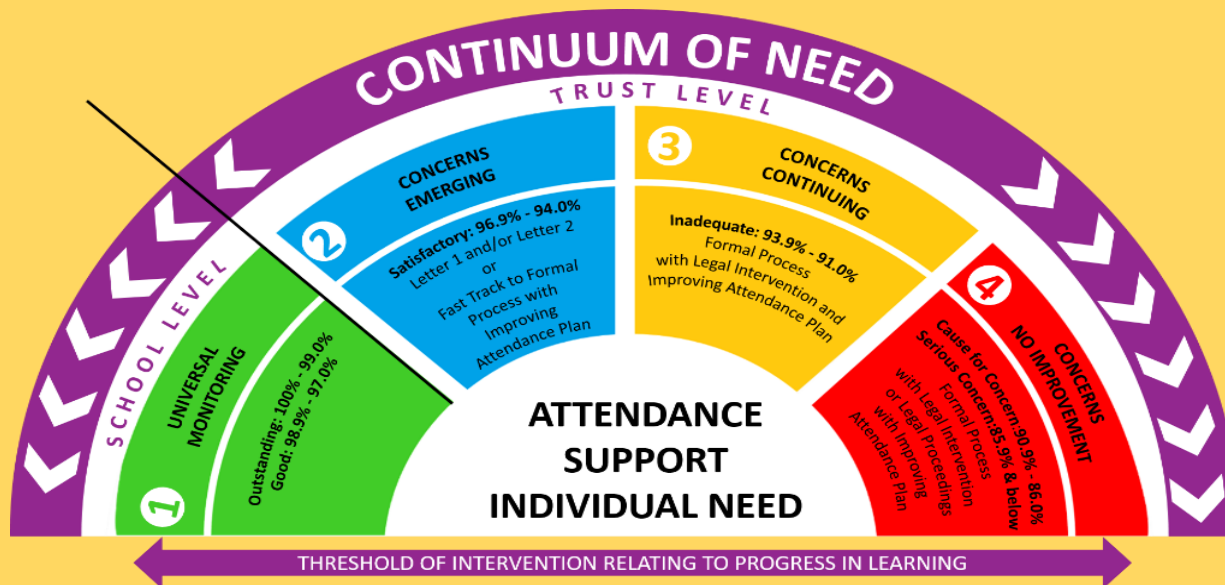
If your child's attendance falls below 97% then our school and NPCAT's monitoring processes begin. Letters and visits from our attendance team will be part of the monitoring process. You will also be invited in to meet the head teacher and to set targets for improvement. Please get in touch with the school as soon as possible if there is a valid medical reason why there is significant attendance issue.

Holidays are not allowed in school term time and will be declined by the head teacher following the policy set out by NPCAT. (Available on our website) Fines are issued by the Local Authority.

Holidays

All holidays will be declined unless they fulfil the exceptional circumstances laid out in our attendance policy and also found on the holiday forms. We monitor all illnesses attached to before or after holidays. Home visits by the NPCAT attendance team will go ahead of we suspect you are on holiday.

Medical Matters



- 0 Any sickness, diarrhoea, must be followed by 48 hrs absence.
- 0 Any absence requires a telephone call explaining why at the main office. Emails are not accepted for absence. Please phone every day that your child is ill.
- 0 Head lice are common! Please check regularly and treat as recommended.
- 0 Any prescribed medicines can only be administered by prior arrangement via the main office. A medical form will need to be filled in.



EYFS

The EYFS Curriculum focuses on 7 different areas of learning. These are:

The three Prime areas are:

Communication and language.

Physical development.

Personal, social and emotional development.

Specific Areas are:

Literacy

Mathematics

Understanding the World

Expressive Arts and Design

All four **areas** represent important features of a child's early development.

How you can help?



- ❖ Reading books (stories, information books, newspapers, magazines, comics etc), encouraging your child to join in and talk about books
- ❖ Singing songs and nursery rhymes
- ❖ Modelling correct letter formation and pencil grip
- ❖ Taking time to listen to them talking about things they've done and answering their questions (You can ask them questions too!!)
- ❖ Maths - sing number songs and count different objects. Look at door numbers and numbers you see in the environment. Ask your child to count out different objects.





30 Hour Nursery

We offer 30 hour provision at St Clare's.

We ask that all 30 hour children have a school lunch. This has worked well in Reception this year and helped children to develop their independent skills and try new things.

The 30 hour provision does not cover lunchtime supervision therefore we will need to charge £3.50 per child for supervision with the additional cost of a school lunch at £2.20 per day. This is payable Monday in advance via ParentPay which is a website used in order to keep the office cashless. Arrears on either account can result in your child's place being withdrawn, without notice.
