

## Feedback from Parental Questionnaires February 2019

Our Parent and Carer Questionnaire was sent out at our Parent's Consultation Evening in February 2019. The results have been analysed once again.

This questionnaire provides parents and carers with the opportunity to say what they like the most about St Edward's and the opportunity to suggest what they feel we could do better.

There has been an increase in almost every single aspect measured in our questions since the last questionnaire in October 2018.

### Enjoying and Achieving

100% of all parents were happy with every single aspect of the 'Enjoying and Achieving' aspect of the questionnaire. This includes how happy and settled their child is, how well they are kept informed and up to date about their child's progress, and overall happiness.

### Making a positive contribution

100% of parents feel comfortable and welcome when visiting St Edward's School. This was echoed in the responses in October 2018.

It was noted that only 54% of parents feel that they know who the governors are. [This information is on our school website and is kept up to date.](#) This was highlighted in October 2018 questionnaire responses.

### Being Healthy and Staying Safe

There was an extremely strong agreement across all responses that children are kept healthy and safe in school. 100% of parents agreed that their child is safe and encouraged to be mature and independent. 99% agree that the school actively works to improve their child's health.

Bullying was also addressed in this section. 84% of parents agreed that bullying is dealt with successfully at St Edward's, whilst a further 15% 'did not know' because they have never experienced bullying here at all. This means that 99% of parents either agree that bullying is successfully dealt with, or have never had experience of bullying at St Edward's. ### Achieving Economic Well-being

100% of parents are happy with their child's overall well-being. All parents also agreed that St Edward's has an interesting and challenging curriculum and are happy with our teaching.

Children at St Edward's are all treated fairly and 97% of parents also agree with this.
